

EXHIBITOR/VENDOR POLICY

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to assure that only authorized exhibitors and vendors be permitted to display and sell their services at Multiple District 14 (Pennsylvania) State Council Meetings and/or State Conventions.

GENERAL:

1. All exhibitors and vendors must follow the Rules and Regulations outlined in a separate agreement.
2. All exhibitors and vendors must have permission of the MD-14 Council of Governors prior to selling or displaying items at any State Council Meeting and/or State Convention.
3. Selling of chances, raffle tickets, merchandise items and commercial displays is not permitted by any sub-district, local Lions, Lioness or Leo club at any State Council Meeting and/or State Convention. **EXCEPTION:** The sub-district hosting the current State Council Meeting or upcoming State Convention may sell chances, raffle tickets or merchandise to defray the cost of the event.
4. No merchandise may be sold that is available through the Pennsylvania State Council of Lions Clubs' Merchandise Store.
5. The chairperson of each year's MD-14 State Convention Host Committee shall present a list of exhibitors and vendors to the Council of Governors for its approval at the third State Council Meeting.
6. No exhibitor or vendor will be accepted after the close of the third State Council Meeting.
7. All revenues received from the exhibitors are considered administrative income and shall be reported on policy 201C.
 - a. The Pennsylvania Lions Sight Conservation & Eye Research Foundation (PLSC&ERF), Pennsylvania Lions Hearing Research Foundation (PLHRF), Lions of Pennsylvania Foundation (LOPF), Pennsylvania Lions Beacon Lodge Camp, Leader Dogs for the Blind, The Pride of Pennsylvania quarterly publication and the following year's State Convention Host Committee shall not be charged a fee.
 - b. The Lions Eye Bank of Delaware Valley, Northeast Pennsylvania Lions Service Foundation, Lion Pin Traders Club of Pennsylvania and other local, district or regional Lions club-supported agencies or projects shall be assessed a fee of \$100.00 per display booth.
 - c. A fee of \$300.00 per display booth will be collected from commercial exhibitors and vendors. All commercial exhibitors are required to provide a certificate of insurance along with their exhibitor's application.
