

CHILDHOOD CANCER COORDINATOR

PURPOSE

The Childhood Cancer Coordinator shall work in liaison with Lions and Leos engaged and interested in projects to expand access to life-saving treatment and provide support to the children and families who face childhood cancers.

GENERAL

1. Qualifications
 - a. A Lion in good standing in Multiple District 14
 - b. A past or present member of a District Childhood Cancer Program
2. Operate in conjunction with Council of Governors, Council Chair, and Multiple District Global Service Team Coordinator
3. A Lion interested in serving as coordinator shall submit a written resume and letter of intent in accordance with Policy 401. The initial coordinator appointment will be made at the adoption of this policy and will thereafter be appointed at the fourth State Council Meeting held in conjunction with the State Convention. The Coordinator shall serve a three-year term and may be reappointed. The appointment may be made from any sub-district in the Multiple District.
4. The Childhood Cancer Coordinator responsibilities:
 - a. Encourage all Districts in Multiple District to participate in Childhood Cancer programs and projects. Encourage District Governors to appoint a District Childhood Cancer Chair/Coordinator.
 - b. Promote sharing of various promotional materials, ideas, available programs and other resources on Childhood Cancer awareness, prevention, and control. Utilize the LCI Childhood Cancer Project Idea List and Childhood Cancer Project Blueprints
 - c. Identify and prioritize Statewide programs, initiatives and organizations related to Childhood Cancer for clubs and districts to support. Evaluate the effectiveness of current projects; develop goals and an overall action plan; inform Lions through the Multiple District Website and PRIDE magazine.

- d. Report to the Council of Governors at the Third Council of Governors Meeting. Expense reimbursement is subject to Policy 204, General Reimbursement Policy to the amount budgeted by the Finance Committee for this position.
- e. Travel throughout the Multiple District, if requested by a district or club, to assist any District Childhood Cancer Coordinator. Travel expenses incurred will be the obligation of the district, club, or other events.
- f. Submit a budget for reporting to the Council of Governors. This must be submitted to the Finance Committee prior to November 30th for the next Lions year.
