## OUR MISSION

## GRANTS

Grant requests for research or clinical projects to be conducted in PA are submitted to the chairperson of the board of directors of the Foundation. Each request is then reviewed by an independent board of ophthalmologic or optometric doctors depending on the nature of the request. The recommendations of the doctors are then reviewed by the Foundation Board of Directors. The board meets quarterly to review and approve the grant requests. Board members serve without compensation in keeping with the motto of Lions Clubs International, "We Serve."

## OUR HISTORY

The Pennsylvania Lions Sight Conservation and Eye Research Foundation was founded in 1959 by a unanimous vote of the Pennsylvania State Council of Lions Clubs.

The Board of Directors consists of six Lions, two members from each region (West, Central and East) in Multiple District 14 (Pennsylvania). Board members are appointed by their respective District Governors and approved by the PA State Council.

## CONTRIBUTIONS

The Foundation funds are raised by the members of Lions, Lioness and Leo Clubs in Pennsylvania. Each of the eighteen districts in Pennsylvania has a district chairperson who solicits funds from each club in his or her district. The funds are forwarded to the Foundation Treasurer.

The board of directors of the Foundation has established a Memorial Endowment Fund. Only the interest from this fund is used for eye research; the principal remains intact. The Memorial Endowment Fund requires a contribution of \$500 or more to honor a Lion, Lioness, Leo, Lions Club or an individual in the community who has been interested in eye research.
